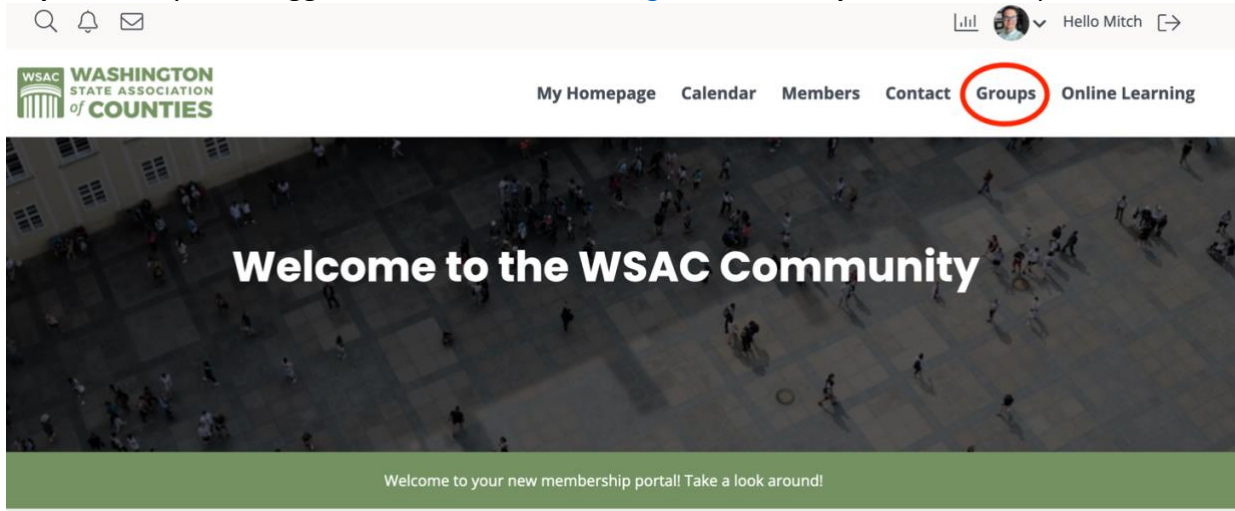
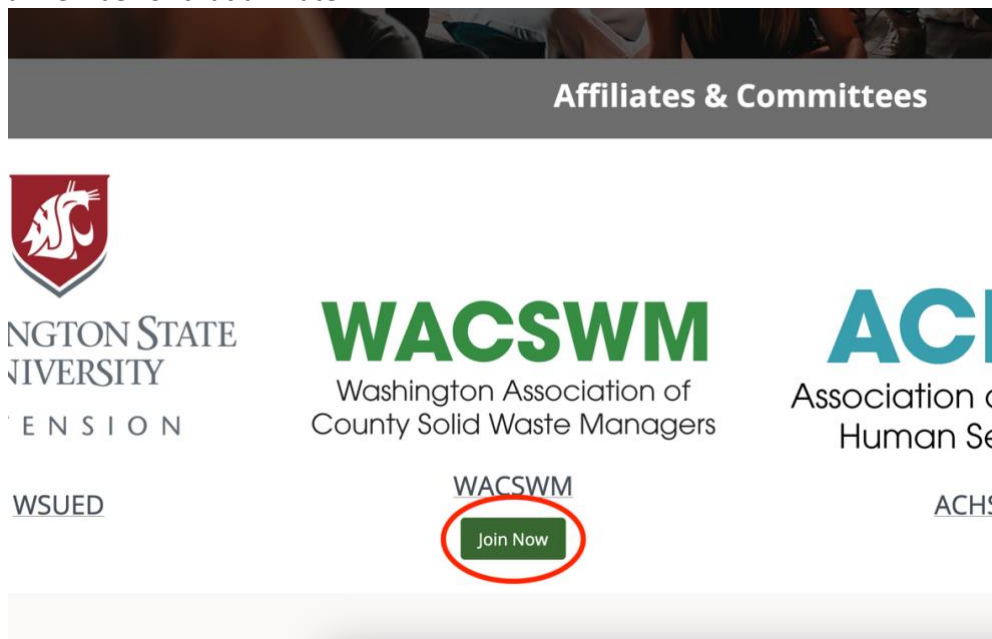


# How to Join Your Affiliate Group in the Association Management System:

**Step 1:** Once you've logged into [members.wsac.org](https://members.wsac.org), select "**Groups**" from the top tab.



**Step 2:** You can scroll left or right, type in your Affiliate acronym, or search it in the dropdown menu. Select "**Join Now.**" An admin of the group will be notified of your request and approve it if you are a member of that affiliate.



**Step 3:** In your Affiliate Group, you'll find resources, see staff contact information, upcoming events, an executive team list, group news, and a members list. Each Affiliate also has a "share" section where you can ask questions, share news, and discuss information important to your industry area.
